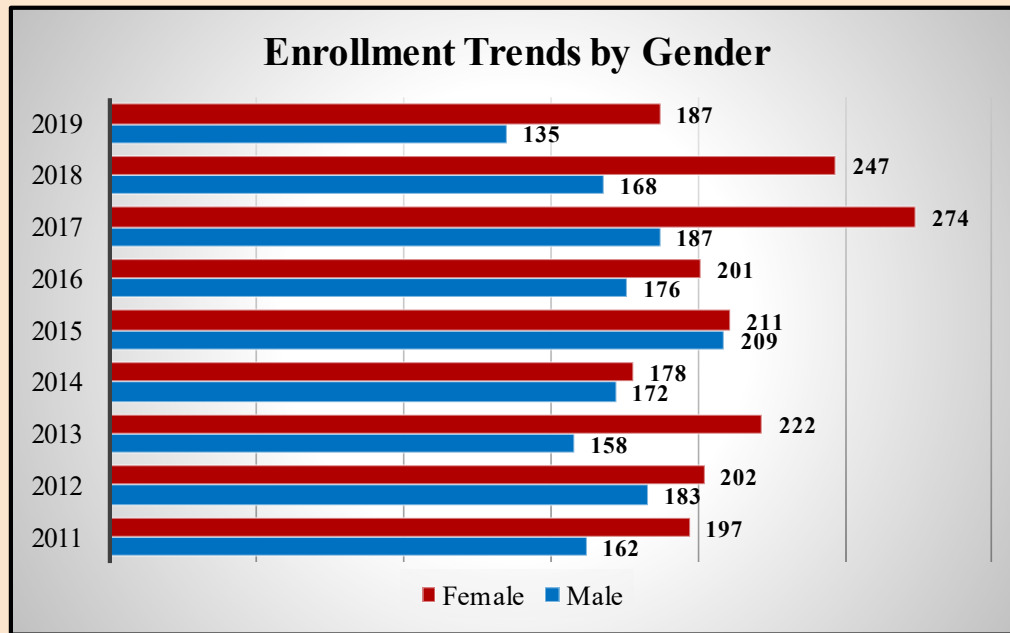




Enrollment Trends for Beginning Freshmen
