GUIDELINES FOR THE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS PROVIDED THROUGH THE EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER NATIONAL BOARD PROGRAM

The following guidelines are intended to supplement the guidelines provided by the National Board for client eligibility and eligible program costs. Any disbursement of funds must continue to meet the National Board's eligibility criteria as well as the local criteria.

- 1) The applicant must be experiencing an economic crisis which threatens the health and safety of a family member such as a child or disabled or elderly adult.
- *a medical crisis can be exempt from income reduction

 2) A household may only be assisted during one economic emergency in an award period.
- 3) The economic emergency must not be the result of non-compliance with other department administered assistance programs.
- 4) For assistance with rent, mortgage and utilities, the applicant must have experienced at least a 50% reduction in income within the last six months. The applicant will be responsible for providing verification of current income and of income prior to the reduction.
- 5) For assistance with past due rent or mortgage, the applicant must have been served with an eviction notice.
- 6) For assistance with metered utilities, the applicant must have been presented with a disconnect notice. For non-metered utilities, verification will be obtained from the supplier that the applicant cannot obtain additional service due to delinquent payment.
- 7) The client will need to have a workable plan for payment of next month's rent, mortgage, utilities, food, etc.
- 8) If the client does not qualify for any of the department administered assistance programs, the economic emergency should be carefully assessed on a case by case basis.


