IMPORTANT DATES

August 10

100% tuition and fees due by 3:00 p.m. (cst). First cancellation for all unpaid accounts. Students will be allowed to re-register if full payment is made.

August 14 \$75 late registration fee applied August 16 On-campus classes commence August 17 100% of tuition and fees due by 3

100% of tuition and fees due by 3:00 p.m. (cst). Final cancellation for all unpaid accounts. This cancellation is final and students will not be allowed to re-register for Fall full term and or Fall Online Term 1.

August 18

Last day for 100% refund of basic tuition and fees. Last day to register for the Comprehensive Exam by noon.

August 25

Last day for 50% refund of basic tuition and fees for withdrawal. Last day for dropping courses without 100% fees due.

What is FERPA?

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), sometimes referred to as the Buckley Amendment, is a federal law that protects the privacy and handling of student educational records. If your student needs to find the FERPA Form, they can visit www.uwa.edu, click the current student, faculty staff tab and then click eforms. Once they are here they will log into their account and click on the FERPA tab.

Bills Must be Paid Before the Semester Begins

Before classes begin, you must pay the full balance due on your student account or be set up on a payment plan and make your first payment before deregistration. Otherwise you will not be allowed to move into your residence hall and your classes due risk of being deregistered.

NOTE: If your account balance is displayed in(parentheses), it means you have a (credit balance) and you do not owe anything, UWA owes you a refund. Refunds will begin being issued during the second week of classes.

Student Loans

Students who have received student loans through their FAFSA can now accept or decline those funds through self-service. Have your student log into their Self-Service account, select "Financial Aid," select the Academic Year and then select "review and accept your Financial Aid award package."

Refunds

Your student can receive their refund by direct deposit. Banking information can be set up in Self-Service under Banking Information. Once you have entered your banking information, we will verify the information. You do not need to re-enter that information again unless you wish to change bank accounts for future disbursements.

The deadline to submit the FAFSA in order to be ready for fall semester is 7/31/23.

The deadline to complete loan entrance counseling and sign a master promissory note (MPN) in time to avoid deregistration is 8/9/23.

Housing Check-In Appointments

• Residents must schedule an appointment for check-in on their MyHousing portal at <u>http://MyHousing.uwa.edu</u>.

• Appointments will be available starting July 10th. The sooner you select, the more time slots that will be available. Residents must schedule an appointment at least 72 hours prior to their check-in date.

• Residents must have a housing assignment in order to select a check-in appointment starting July 10th. Therefore, first-year students who have not matched with a roommate yet, should plan to do so by July 2nd so they can select their room on July 5th.

Renter's Insurance

UWA strongly encourages residents to have renter's insurance if they are not already covered by a parent's homeowner's insurance or other renter's insurance policy. Renter's insurance can protect both yourself and your property in case of accidents, which is helpful when living in a large community. If you do not already have a policy, UWA Housing partners with **GradGuard** to offer an easy, low-cost option for renter's insurance – it includes a low deductible, worldwide property coverage (belongings can be protected on campus and when traveling), and personal liability coverage (if you unintentionally cause damage). Residents are able to opt in to or decline the GradGuard insurance option as part of the Housing application. If a resident opted in, they will see the charge on their credit card in July. If they did not opt-in, but would like to do so now, they may revisit their Housing application in their MyHousing portal OR visit **www.GradGuard.com**to sign up.

Keep In The Know

Residents should be checking their UWA email address on a regular basis, at least every 2 - 3 days, for communication from the Office of Housing and Resident Life and other UWA offices.
