TRANSFER PROCESS

TRANSFER STUDENTS WHO WISH TO ATTEND THE UNIVERSITY OF WEST ALABAMA MUST COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- 1 Submit an admissions application online and pay the \$30 non-refundable application fee.
- 2 Request your official college transcripts to be sent to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions and Enrollment Management from your current and previously attended institutions.
- 3 If you are transferring with less than 24 transferable hours, you must also submit an official high school transcript and appropriate ACT or SAT test scores.
- 4 Once tentatively accepted, complete your medical history form and submit all required immunizations.

The cost for tuition, fees, meals, and a space in a residence hall for one academic year is as follows:

SCHOLARSHIPS & AID

Our Transfer Scholarships are a great opportunity to lessen the burden of college. Don't forget to complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) beginning on October 1.

Scholarships are available for full-time transfer students with at least 24 hours of transferable credits, which are based on your GPA from all transcripts. Once meeting all the listed requirements you will be awarded.

Scholarships are renewable for up to two academic years as long as you maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
